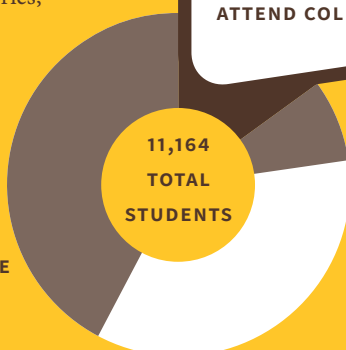


Who We Are

Students concentrate in one or two areas of study but often complete coursework across several disciplines, pursuing additional learning opportunities through research, internships, international study and community-based projects.

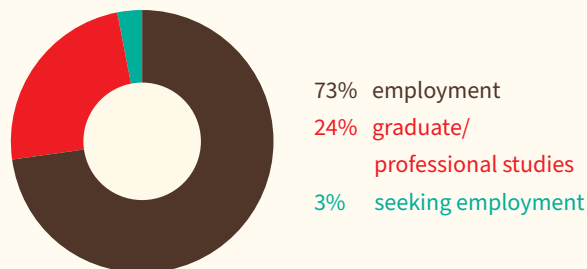

Post-graduate activity data for Class of 2025 graduates*

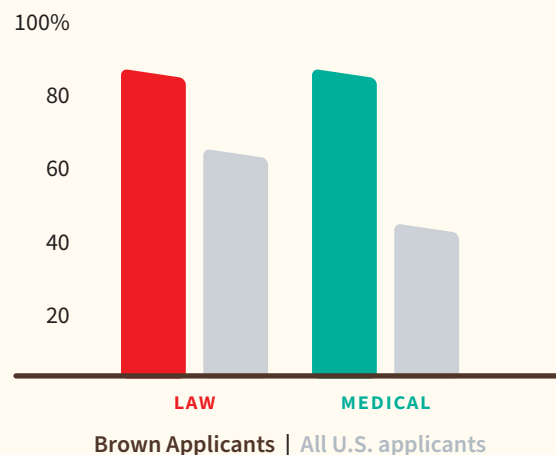
